How to assign access levels in a segmented system from multiple segments

## **Procedure Steps**

In order for users from one segment to assign access levels from another segment, an option in the Segments folder must be enabled.

In System Administration:

- 1) From the **Administration** menu, select **Segments**.
- 2) On the Segment Options form, select the **Allow access levels to be configured as assignable by users in other segments** check box.
- 3) Once this option is enabled, log out of System Administration and then log in again.
- 4) From the **Access Control** menu, select **Access Levels**. The Access Level Additional Segments form will be added, allowing you to select an access level and give other segments access to it.

## For example:

A user in Segment 1 creates a front door access level. On the Access Level Additional Segments form, the user can then give access to Segment 2 users to assign this access level. When Segment 2 users log in, they can assign this access level, but cannot modify or delete it.

**Note:** Segment 1 must be configured for access in order for Segment 2 users to give access to areas in Segment 1.
