How to configure SQL Server 2005 Express if the installation utility was not used.

Procedure Steps

- 1) Click the **Start** button, then select **All Programs > SQL Server 2005 > Configuration Tools > SQL Server Configuration Manager**.
- 2) Expand **SQL Server 2005 Network Configuration** and click **Protocols for MSSQLSERVER**.
- 3) Make sure that the **TCP/IP** and **Named Pipes** protocols are enabled. If they are not, right-click the protocol and select **Enable**.
- 4) Exit **SQL Server 2005 Network Configuration**.
- 5) Click the **Start** button, then select **All Programs > SQL Server 2005 > Configuration Tools > SQL Server 2005 Surface Area Configuration**.
- 6) Click the **Surface Area Configuration for Services and Connections** link.
- 7) Expand **MSSQLSERVER > Database Engine** and click **Remote Connections**. Enable the **Local and remote connections** and **Using both TCP/IP and Named Pipes** radio buttons.
