

Token-based server access violation failed with an infrastructure error

Symptom

Login failed for user ". Reason: Token-based server access validation failed with an infrastructure error. Check for previous errors. [CLIENT: x.x.x.x]

Resolution

The failed login attempts came from a video process for the Access Control system.

The sessions indicate the attempts came from the **LnVideoComSrvr** application.

To stop the failed logins and gain access to the AccessControl database, enable the login and grant it the correct permissions.

Another option is to disable UAC.
