# Napco Trilogy Networx Wireless Lock Gateway will not come online

### Symptom

Napco Trilogy Networx Wireless Lock Gateway will not come online. When running the Lantronix Device Installer, the firmware shows 6.9.0.4 (or a similar firmware). When running the Napco Manager, the firmware shows 5.43.

#### Resolution

The Trilogy Networx Wireless Gateways are shipped from the factory with the alarm lock firmware preinstalled. You must change the firmware to the correct version for OnGuard.

- 1. Factory default the gateway:
- 2
- a. Make sure the Gateway is connected to a router (or network). The Gateway cannot be reset wirelessly.
- b. With power applied, press and hold the RESET button. The red LED lights continuously.
- c. Continue to press and hold the RESET button. The red LED will flash.
- d. When the red LED lights continuously again, release the RESET button. The red LED turns off.
- e. After several seconds, the red LED will flash again.
- 3. Discover the Gateway using the Lantronix device installer and set the IP address only.
- 4. Open the Napco Device Manager program.
- 5.
- a. This is located in C:\Program Files (x86)\OnGuard.
- b. It is automatically installed on the computer that has the Napco accessory add-on installed.
- 6. Run the Napco Device Manager and find the Gateway.
- 7. Upgrade the gateway firmware. The installer automatically chooses the correct firmware for this version of wireless locks.
- 8. Discover the lock using the Napco Manager.
- 9. Link it to the gateway.
- 10. Upgrade the firmware on the lock.
- 11. Configure the lock in OnGuard.
